General Questions

What is Coptic Scholar?

It is an ebook platform & self-publishing app to read and distribute books, magazines and articles in an electronic format.

Who may use Coptic Scholar?

Coptic Scholar was designed to read electronic books on your phone at any time. Authors and publishers may self-publish and sell their books worldwide.

How to get Coptic Scholar App?

You may download this app from App Store and Google Play.



How much does it cost?

This app is free. All free books are available for all readers. Books for sale require purchase to be able to read. The author or publishers are the one who put the price of their own books.

Who is the developer of this App and program?

This app is developed by Holy Sophia University, the Coptic Orthodox University located in the U.S.A. Its President is His Holiness Pope Tawadros II. The Vice-President is HG Bishop David of the Coptic Orthodox Diocese of New York & New England. Its administration dean is Fr. Abraham Azmy. The app is continuously maintained by one of the companies specialized in ebook programming.

How does this app protect the copyright of the published material?

Every book or material published on Coptic Scholar is given an international number called CSBN (Coptic Scholar Book Number) designed exclusively for Coptic Scholar program. For security reasons, any copyright purposes.

How does this app protect the privacy of the users?

Any information or transaction associated with any book sale is coded and is not saved in any form after completing the transaction.

As an author or publisher, how much royalties do you get from Coptic Scholar?

After paying all appropriate fees to Apple, Google, and the 3% fees of using the bank credit card process, you will get 80 percent of the revenue generated by the sale of your Book.

Do all ebooks have the same features on Coptic Scholar app?

No. There are two kinds of ebooks format. The first one has a fixed format and is derived from pdf files. Every page has a fixed format of text and photos if available. There is no text flow or capability to increase the size of the font. You can only zoom in to better read the book. In this case, you need to move the page around to read it. This kind of books is used in books with graphics or pictures to maintain their format. The other kind uses text-flow capability to enlarge or reduce the font. It has many features such as using highlight in the book or underlines. You may write your own notes, bookmarks, etc.

Coptic Scholar uses both kinds of ebooks. It is up to the author or publisher to choose which format that could be used for each book.






Once you create your account, you will be able to use all features of the app and service



You can go to any category of (Books, Magazines, Research, Articles) to open their own sub-categories




For example, when you open the Category of Books, you will see all Sub-Categories arranged alphabetically


When you open the Contents, you can choose any chapter to go to




When you click on Highlights, you can see all your highlights. When you click on any highlight, it will take you there.




When you slide any highlight to the left, you will have 2 choices, either you delete the highlight, or you choose to write your own notes




On clicking on **Delete**, the highlight will be deleted. On clicking on **Notes**, you can write your own notes. Do not forget to save your note.




After saving, you will see your own notes underneath the highlighted sentence (the yellow one here).




If you would like to add Bookmarks, you can do so by clicking on the Bookmark sign.




This will open a window for Bookmarks




If you go to the Bookmarks tab, you will find all your bookmarks. From there, you can go to any of them.






Coptic Scholar will remind you all the time to continue your reading from where you stopped.

You can find your Library, by going to setting, then clicking on the **Red Heart** to see all books you added to your digital library.





For Authors & Publishers How can you publish and sell your books on Coptic Scholar?

Any user of Coptic Scholar can apply to get a new account on Coptic Scholar server to publish and sell their own books.


You need to be the legal owner of your material that has no violations of any copyright laws. Every time you publish a new book, you confirm that you are the legal owner of this book. If it appears that you are not the owner of your published book, your account will be deleted, and you will carry legal consequences. Please review all terms and conditions at the end of this manual.

How to get an account of the publishing server of Coptic Scholar?

Go to Coptic Scholar Setting, then click on "Wants to become an author?" at the bottom of the setting tab.



This will open a new window. You need to fill all information and upload your photo. Coptic Scholar will communicate with you regarding this matter.



When you are accepted to be an author or publisher, you will be given an account on Coptic Scholar server for self-publishing books on:



Steps you need to take as an author or publisher:

- Prepare your book on Microsoft Word. Use Word to add headers 1 & 2 level.
- Prepare the book cover.
- Determine if the book will be in fixed format of Pdf or ePub format with text flow.
- Prepare the first 15 to 20 pages as a free sample for all readers.
- If your book is a Pdf, you do not need anything else, just you need to upload it and put its price.
- If your book is intended to have text-flow, you need to download Calibre program to convert your word document to ePub file that will be uploaded. This is an easy step, and it can be done in a few minutes.
- This is the official site to download "Calibre". This is a free program that works on windows as well as on apple.




- Open Calibre, then apload your book in word document on (1) Add Books
- Your book will appear with a generic cover on (4).
- Click on (2) Edit metadata to add the author and the cover.


- Write the book title in (1)

(3) Convert books




- Now, click on (3) Convert books. This will open a new window.




- Just write down h1 in (1), h2 in (2), h3 in (3).

Converting Word File to ePub



- After clicking on OK to convert the file, the new (1) ePub file will appear.
- Open the **folder (2)** to take the file and to upload it on Coptic Scholar.

Uploading ePub files on the server



- (1) Choose a category for your material (Books, Magazines, Research, Articles). For your new book, you choose Books.
- (2) Choose the sub-categories for your book.
- (3) Your name as an author will appear here.
- (4) Write your book title.
- (5) The international CSBN number is assigned automatically.
- (6) Set your book price.
- (7) Write a brief description about your book.
- (8) Choose your book COVER.
- (9) Choose file source of your book sample (choose local).
- (10) Upload the sample file (15-20 pages including the cover).
- (11) Choose file source of your book (choose local).
- (12) Upload the ePub file of your book.
- (13) Save your book to appear immediately on Coptic Scholar bookshelves.
- (14) It will show you all purchase history of your book.
- (15) It will show all transaction history.
- (16) This is to withdraw from your book revenue.
- (17) This is to convert the same window into Arabic.

Terms and Conditions

Coptic Scholar is a self-publishing and ebook distribution platform.

This Agreement provides the terms and conditions of your participation in the Coptic Scholar ("CS") self-publication and distribution App ("App") as well as the Coptic Scholar website ("Website") at http://copticscholar.com/ and your distribution of digital content through the App.

This agreement (the "Agreement") is a binding agreement between the individual or the entity identified in your Coptic Scholar account as ("You", "Author" or "Publisher") and ("CS").

The following terms and conditions govern all use of the Coptic Scholar App and Website.

Terms of Service

1 Agreement Acceptance. Acceptance of the Agreement. Before accessing or using the Website or App, please read this Agreement carefully. You agree to be governed by the terms and conditions of this agreement by accessing or using any element of the Website or App. You may not access the Website, App, or use any services if you do not agree to all of the terms and conditions of this agreement. If the Publisher is a legal entity, the individual accepting this Agreement on behalf of the Publisher represents and warrants that he or she is allowed to enter this Agreement as Publisher's authorized representative and to bind Publisher to its provisions.

2 Amendment to the Agreement. Because the App will evolve over time, the terms of this Agreement will need to evolve as well. We reserve the right, in our sole discretion, to amend the terms of this Agreement at any time. Your Coptic Scholar Account

Book Rejection.

In our sole discretion, we have the right to decide what content we accept and distribute through the App. You represent and warrant that any information and documentation you provide to us in response to such a request will be current, complete, and accurate. If we request additional information relating to your Books, such as information confirming that you have all rights required to permit our distribution of the Books, you will promptly provide the information requested. You authorize us to make whatever enquiries we deem necessary, directly or through third parties, to verify your rights to allow us to distribute the Books and the accuracy of the information or documents you submit to us regarding those rights.

Pricing.

- 1 Providing the Price of Your Book. You have the right to determine the price of your book sale. Your Royalty is calculated depending on your Book Price. You can change the price of your book at any time.
- 2 Conversion of currencies. We may be able to sell your book in a variety of currencies. When we do, we may convert the Book Price you provide to other currencies at a rate we establish according to the financial market. The converted Book Price may be updated on a regular basis to reflect current currency rates.

Royalties and Payments.

- 1 Royalties. After paying all appropriate fees to Apple, Google, and the 3% fees of using the bank credit card process, we shall pay you 80 percent of the revenue generated by the sale of your Books conditioned that you do not break your responsibilities under this Agreement.
- 2 When We Have Paid You. We will pay royalties on book sales 60 days after the end of the calendar month in which they occurred. We will provide you with an online report outlining Book sales and accompanying Royalties at the time of payment.
- 3 Currencies for payment. If you change your payment currency, it will take effect on the first of the next calendar month (unless we make an earlier period available). If we pay you in a currency other than the Sale Currency, we shall convert the Royalties due from the Sale Currency to the payment currency at a rate we determine, which will include all conversion costs and charges.
- 4 Payment Disputes. You may not file a lawsuit or other legal action against us in connection with any statement unless you do so within six months after the statement's availability. Any such procedure will be restricted to determining the amount of money owed to you by us for the accounting periods in question, and your only remedy will be to collect those funds without interest.
